It is written in honour of the 6th Century Irish Missionary, St Cairell who established a Christian centre near Roy Bridge in Brae Lochaber. The highest knoll on the site is Tom Angeal (the Hill of the Angels), an ancient burial ground, the final resting place of laity, priests and bishops of Lochaber. The beautiful ancient chapel below Tom Angeal is known as Cille Choirill. It is fully restored and in regular liturgical use, thanks to the generosity of the descendants of Lochaber people who emigrated to Nova Scotia at the end of the nineteenth century.
